Scholarships awarded by the Foundation exclusively support students who attend the WVU at Parkersburg Campus, the Jackson County Center Campus or the Pleasants County PRT Center automotive program. **In order to qualify for a WVU at Parkersburg Foundation Scholarship, students must FIRST apply for admission to WVU at Parkersburg and THEN fully complete the Foundation Scholarship application.**

Foundation Scholarship Awards are selected with careful attention and consideration given to the wishes of its donors. Please review all Scholarship criteria to ensure that your application is appropriate. Please be advised the majority of academically based Scholarships require the following:

Graduating High School Seniors: Minimum of a 22 ACT enhanced or 3.2 cumulative GPA

Current College Students: Minimum 3.2 cumulative GPA

GED Graduates: Submit GED Test Score
