

## **SMOKING POLICY (Answer Book**

### **#VIII-5, August 19, 1991)**

Recognizing its obligation to provide a safe and healthy environment for students, faculty, staff, and visitors, it is the policy of West Virginia University at Parkersburg to promote a smoke-free environment in the campus facilities. Smoking is therefore prohibited in all facilities of West Virginia University at Parkersburg effective August 19, 1991. This policy also applies to the Jackson County Center facility and all state vehicles owned by WVU-P.

“Smoke-Free Environment” signs are displayed in appropriate locations. Educational programs on health issues related to tobacco use and smoking cessation workshops will be provided to employees and students.

It is the responsibility of all members of the WVU-P community to observe this policy.
