Adjunct Instructor Positions for
Expanded Access Program:
Using Technology to Train Nurses in Our Rural Communities

West Virginia University at Parkersburg seeks applications and/or nominations for six (6) part-time hourly adjunct appointments to staff Learning Centers at local hospitals and clinics. Duties will include supervising students entering the Nursing Career Ladder from remediation through coursework as it becomes available via on-line or two-way videoconferencing beginning January, 2010. The positions are part-time* (less than 0.53 FTE; less than 975 hours annually) and will include course planning and instruction for the state curriculum for nursing assistants, both in classroom and clinical settings. The Health Sciences Division values creativity and innovation and expects the selected candidates will participate actively in the college community.

Qualifications include two years experience working as a registered nurse, with at least one year employment in an approved long term care facility. Successful candidates will be required to attend the Educate the Educator Training or qualify for exemption. West Virginia RN licensure or eligibility for such licensure is required. The successful candidate(s) must function effectively as a team member and have good organization and communication skills. Teaching experience is preferred, as well as an aptitude for using technology in instructional delivery.

These are new positions created as part of a 3-year Department of Labor grant that will staff learning centers in Tyler, Ritchie, Pleasants, Roane, Jackson, and Wood Counties. Instruction will be delivered through a team teaching model with an instructor at each learning center. It is the goal of the program to become self sufficient and to continue the program after the expiration of grant funding.

*Appointment or re-appointment is on a semester by semester basis. Pay scale is \$25.00/hour. No fringe benefits will be available. Candidates must be willing to work evening and weekends.
