Welding Instructional Specialist

West Virginia University at Parkersburg seeks applications and/or nominations for a nine-month, renewable 1-3 year term appointment as a Welding Instructional Specialist effective January, 2010. The appointment will include teaching and training responsibilities within a 37.5 hour work week. In addition, major duties will include academic advising, relevant committee service, student recruitment/retention and professional development activities related specifically to the duties of the position. The position is eligible for renewal for the 2010-2011 academic year.

Teaching assignments may include evenings, weekends, off-campus locations, on-line delivery methods, and credit and non-credit course offerings. The Science and Technology Division values creativity and innovation and expects the selected candidate will participate actively in the college community.

Prospective candidates must have at least an associate degree in welding and 5 years experience in the field of welding and machine operation or fabrication. Candidates also qualify if they are AWS certified welding inspectors or certified welding educators. Candidates must also have certifications in GMAW, SMAW, GTAW, and FCAW in plate and pipe. Candidates must be safety oriented and provide a work history which indicates safe operation in the welding, machine operation, and fabrication areas. "Hands-on" teaching experience at the college level is preferred. Demonstration of teaching effectiveness is part of the on campus interview.

Salary and rank are commensurate with education and experience. Review of applications will begin 11/01/2009 and continue until filled.
