Class Descriptions

Below are descriptions that overview the content offered in each class.

- **Arts & Crafts**- Students will be guided through arts and crafts projects while learning various techniques and tips.
- **Farm Technology** – Students will explore fun and new innovative farming technologies! They will see how robot farming functions and the benefits that are associated with using robotics in farming
- **CSI** – Students will learn about finger printing and criminal science investigation
- **Welding** - Welding is a way of heating pieces of metal using electricity or a flame so that they melt and stick together. *Students participating need to wear closed toed shoes, preferably boots, as well as denim pants.*
- **CoBot** - CoBot stands for collaborative robot. The latest technology in robotics that has revolutionized the world of automation.
- **Fun with Science** – Learn some physics, engineering, and chemistry
- **American Sign Language** – Students will learn the basics of American Sign Language
- **Painting** – Students will be learning painting techniques
- **Geology** – Learn the minerals and fossils of West Virginia; who lived in WV in the past? Dinosaurs and giant sloths to name a few.
- **Music Technology** - Music production is much more widely accessible with recent technology advancements; students learn how to create music with minimal equipment, and how to work collaboratively in a production setting
- **Basketball** – Students will learn the basics of basketball
- **Pen Pal** – Learn how to write a letter, address an envelope, and paint a bookmark. Students will be able to send their letter to a local nursing home residents.
- **Kitchen Basics/Table setting** – Learn how to help your parents in the kitchen. Don't worry we will make cupcakes too!
- **Beginning Drawing** – Learn the basics of drawing things like shapes and using those shapes to construct characters
- **Kids in Motion** – This class will focus on speed, agility, explosiveness, strength, and conditioning.
- **Creative Writing** – Students get a chance to be authors while learning how to craft and develop their own stories.
- **Sensory Crafts** – Students will be guided through the process of making various sensory based crafts.
