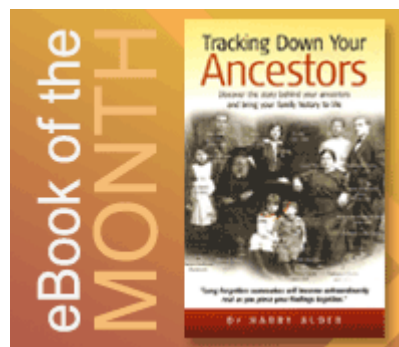

If Netlibrary finds books containing your search terms, it first displays search results screens with brief records for your titles. Use the search results page numbers and the "Next" and "Previous" links to browse the records.

The brief records contain basic publication information for the book plus the text where your terms first appear.

To read a book, click on the "View this eBook" link. This opens the reader and displays the cover of the book.

Search

At the reader, the text of the book appears on the right. Use the "Previous" and "Next" buttons in the upper right corner to read the text. The table of contents appears on the left. Click on the chapter-heading link to go to the first page of the chapter. To search for materials within the text of a single book, enter your search terms in the "Search this eContent" window on the left side of the screen, then click on the "Search" button. Netlibrary will retrieve those parts of the text containing your search terms.

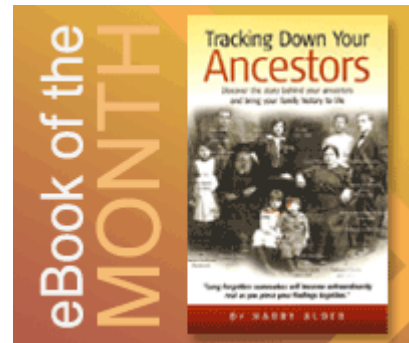
