

## **WHEN**

Classes at West Virginia University at Parkersburg begin as early at 8:00 a.m. and some may run until 11 p.m. There are classes on Saturday mornings and others that meet at irregular intervals or at the student's convenience. However, the administrative offices and other functional areas maintain **HOURS OF OPERATION** which may extend through all class times. The hours of operations are:

Health Services Center	8 am-4 pm (M-F)
Cafeteria	7:30 am-9 pm (M-TH) 7:30 am-2 pm (Friday) (Saturdays as posted) (shorter hours during summer and between semesters)
Night Director	1-9 pm. (M-Th) 10-6 (F) (when classes are in session)
Activities Center	Hours and activities are posted
Bookstore	Hours are posted
Library Hours	are posted in Library or call 424-8260.
Student Assistance Center	8 am-7 pm (M-TH) 8 am-4 pm (FR) (during Fall and Spring semesters)
Computer Lab	8 am-10 pm (M-FR) 9 am - 12:30 pm (SAT) (During Fall & Spring Semesters)

The building is considered closed, with no classes or only limited activities scheduled, from Noon on Saturday until 7:30 a.m. on Monday.

A student should refer to the academic schedule, the ON-CAMPUS and the WVU at Parkersburg CHRONICLE for schedules of activities and events.

## **SUMMER HOURS**

Most college services are continued through the summer on the 8 am-4 pm daily schedule. Some individual offices and functions, however, operate on a reduced schedule, depending upon demand. Evening services in the summer are determined by the extent of the evening class schedule.

## **WEATHER CANCELLATIONS**

Students may check on the status of classes being held or postponed by calling the college's main switchboard (424-8000 or 1-800-WVA-WVUP) or the Public Information Office (424-8203). Also, area radio and television stations broadcast any campus weather closings or delays. (Example) A two hour delay will mean that classes scheduled for 10 a.m. or later will be held.
