

A Required Federal Report Under the Student Right-to-Know

Under this new law colleges are required to keep records of on-campus crimes reported to campus security officials or local law enforcement agencies. The college is required to publish such statistics and distribute them to all employees and currently enrolled students. The report must also be made available to applicants upon request. This report includes statistics for the period of May 16, 2008 through May 15, 2009. These statistics are reported in the right column in the table below.

As you can see, West Virginia University at Parkersburg has been crime-free.
