

WHEN

Classes at WVU Parkersburg begin as early at 8:00 a.m. and some may run until 11 p.m. There are classes on Saturday mornings and others that meet at irregular intervals or at the student's convenience. However, the administrative offices and other functional areas maintain **HOURS OF OPERATION** which may extend through all class times. The hours of operations are:
