MINUTES WEST VIRGINIA UNIVERSITY AT PARKERSBURG BOARD OF GOVERNORS November 9, 2016

A regular meeting of the West Virginia University at Parkersburg Board of Governors was held on Wednesday November 9, 2016, in the President's Board Room at the WVU Parkersburg Campus, beginning at 3:15 p.m. Board members present were: Jeff Matheny, Donna Smith, Steve Hardman, Joseph Oliverio, Jason Landers, Cheryl Donohoe, John Denbigh, John Hushion, Cody Irick, Matthew Santer, and William Bell. Others present included Dr. Fletcher Lamkin and Brady Whipkey.

Guests present included administrators, faculty, and staff.

1. Call to Order

Mr. Matheny, Chair of the WVU at Parkersburg Board of Governors, called the meeting to order.

2. Swearing in of New Board Members

Debbie Richards, Special Assistant to the President, conducted the swearing in of new Board members Joseph Oliverio, Jason Landers and John Hushion.

3. Roll Call

Roll Call was taken by Brady Whipkey, Executive Assistant to the President, noting that a quorum was present.

Resolved, That the West Virginia University at Parkersburg Board of Governors approves the non-credit lab fee attached to co-requisite courses.
