With this program, students will obtain the necessary credentials and skill set needed to be successful in a skilled trades career. Students will achieve an associate degree, sponsored by Constellium Rolled Products Ravenswood, LLC and other state agencies. There is a commitment of employment with Constellium for no less than five years following successful program completion. Should a student be unable to fulfill the program/employment commitment (excluding circumstances beyond their control), the student or their parent will be responsible for repayment of tuition costs for the program. Scholarship recipients will be selected based on GPA, school attendance, letters of recommendation and interview process.
