This position performs duties under the supervision of the Physical Plant Manager II and applies a variety of finishes and materials to repair surfaces to enhance the appearance of the campus facilities.

Duties:

- Applies various finishes and materials to repair surfaces. Performs spray painting with equipment within necessary guidelines and conditions. Ensures that proper mediums, application techniques and safety guidelines are followed during application processes to obtain maximum adhesion and protection of various projects. Professionally finishes and/or refinishes wooden surfaces. Repairs and professionally finishes drywall and plaster as required ensuring top coat application. Properly prepares surfaces for painting utilizing a variety of hand and power tools ensuring proper operation and safety techniques.
- Assists with other trade areas including demolition, new construction, ceiling tile, plumbing, lighting and snow removal as needed.
- Keeps work areas, storage, tools and equipment well maintained and organized.
- Other duties as assigned.
