Function/Summary

The Student Success Coach for the new Cloud Computing associate degree provides personalized advising, mentorship, and structured peer support to help students navigate their academic pathways and overcome barriers to success. This position plays a critical role in increasing student retention, persistence, and program completion. The Student Success Coach will develop individualized success plans, monitor academic progress, and maintain regular communication with students to foster engagement and accountability. The coach will coordinate peer-to-peer learning opportunities, connect students with campus and community resources, and collaborate with faculty to support early intervention strategies. By building strong relationships and offering proactive, student-centered guidance, the Student Success Coach enhances the overall student experience and contributes to the long-term success of the Cloud Computing program.

- Develop individualized academic plans outlining required courses, recommended sequencing, and anticipated milestones from enrollment through completion.
- Integrate Learn and Earn opportunities in collaboration with the Learn and Earn
- Coordinator to provide hands-on, work-based learning tailored to each student's goals.

- Guide students toward relevant industry certifications (AWS, CompTIA, etc.) and incorporate certification pathways into their academic plan.
- Conduct regular plan reviews to monitor progress and ensure students remain on track for timely completion.
- Hold recurring advising sessions with students to review academic progress, address challenges, and adjust plans as needed.
- Utilize early-alert and student progress monitoring systems to identify at-risk students and coordinate timely, proactive interventions.
- Maintain accurate and thorough documentation of advising sessions, academic plans, referrals, and interventions. Tracking data for NSF/ATE Grant.
- Support cohort scheduling where possible by organizing grouped schedules for core Cloud Computing courses to promote peer learning, collaboration, and a sense of belonging.
- Encourage participation in peer support activities, study groups, and mentoring opportunities within the program.
- Connect students with appropriate academic and non-academic support services, including tutoring, financial aid counseling, academic coaching, disability services, and mental health resources.
- Ensure students understand how to access available campus and community resources to support both academic and personal success.
