## Class Descriptions

Below are descriptions that overview the content offered in each class.

- **Arts & Crafts**- students to be guided through arts and crafts projects while learning various techniques and tips.
- **Media Studies** – Students will learn about the basics of media art, including radio, photography, graphic design, and video production.
- **General Programming** - Learn the applications of programming, how to get started, as well as an overview of the top three computer code languages. Programming is a language used by humans to communicate with computers. *Please bring your own laptop; if you do not have one, we can provide one.*
- **Welding** - Welding is a way of heating pieces of metal using electricity or a flame so that they melt and stick together. *Students participating need to wear closed toed shoes, preferably boots, as well as denim pants.*
- **Beginning Drawing** – Learn the basics of drawing with things like shapes and using those shapes to construct characters
- **CoBot** - CoBot stands for collaborative robot. The latest technology in robotics that has revolutionized the world of automation.
- **Chemistry** - Chemistry is the study of matter and the changes that take place with that matter. Chemistry looks at the ways matter changes and transforms to create the Universe that you know.
- **Farm Technology** – Students will explore fun and new innovative farming technologies! We will see how robot farming functions and the benefits that are associated with going to robotics in farming.
- **Bookmaking** – The Art of Bookmaking will introduce students to basic concepts and techniques for making their own interactive books from pages to cover. Students will also learn about the ancient art of Suminagashi and create their own marbled paper to be used in their books. No experience needed.
- **Photography** – Photography is a complex art, and science. In this class, students will learn how to use their cameras, the fundamental rules and principles of photography, and how to hone their craft. *\*You will need to bring your own camera; any kind will do.*
- **Archeology** - Archeology is the study of things that people made, used, and left behind. The goal of archeology is to understand what people of the past were like and how they lived.
- **Music Technology** - music production is much more widely accessible with recent technology advancements; students learn how to create music with minimal equipment, and how to work collaboratively in a production setting
- **Intro to Making** – making is a broad term often associated with those who use multiple tools and technologies to complete projects. In this course, students will learn about technologies like 3D printing, laser cutting, and more, as it relates to the modern maker.
- **Journaling** - Learn how to manage your time, thoughts, projects, and to-do lists creatively.
- **Geology** – Learn the minerals and fossils of West Virginia; who lived in WV in the past? Dinosaurs and giant sloths to name a few.
- **Bird-O-Rama** – Learn about backyard birds, their special adaptations, and create your own bird feeder to take home
- **Creative Writing** – students get a chance to be authors while learning how to craft and develop their own stories.
- **Space and Rocketry** – Rockets are devices that produce the force, or push, needed to move an object forward. Learn how rockets work, how they are made, and key terms associated with rocketry.
